I understand that the class has on-line prelabs which is due at 5pm on Mondays and the deadline is absolute. Even if the server dies, the internet melts and the world ends. The internet is everwhere, lack of internet access will not be believed. I understand that the homework appears at noon on Thursday. My prelabs are limited to five attempts.

I understand that the labs must be done in the classroom 107 MCH. Labs can be completed in one of the in-lab office hours; but have to be completed by 5pm on the next Monday and sometimes earlier.
